

# Important Parent Reminder

## Medication Check List

PLEASE CHECK THE FOLLOWING BEFORE DROPPING OFF YOUR STUDENT'S MEDICATION AT CAMP

- All medications are in original pharmacy labeled bottle or over the counter containers. If brought in an unlabeled container or baggie it **will not** be accepted.
- Inhalers and Epinephrine injectors need pharmacy labels on the box or the inhaler/epi injector itself. If you need an extra label, contact your pharmacist or physician's office. Hand written names on the inhaler/epi injector is **not** acceptable. A photocopy of the label is acceptable.
- Medication **will not** be accepted with an expired date.
- **ALL** medications must have a completed medication authorization form for each medication provided. Each form must have a parent/guardian **AND** physician signature (one medication per form).
- All medications must be checked in with staff and not packed in your student's bag.
- Put all medications that are in their original boxes in a gallon size zip lock bag with your child's name labeled on it/
- All medications must be picked up by the parent/guardian.
- All forms and medications must be submitted.
  - Waiver for Dispensing of Medication - parent signature
  - Prescription form (if needed) – parent AND physician signature
  - Non-Prescription form (if needed) – parent AND physician signature
